WEEKEND TOURNAMENT RULES

Contest Days: **September 24 and 25, 2011**

Entry Fee (*non-refundable*): **\$300 per person per contest**

(*Early Bird Entry Fee of \$280 per contest if paid by September 8*)

There is a two-day tournament on Thoroughbred races conducted at Fairplex Park on Saturday, September 24 and Sunday, September 25.

- **Non-Members of the 2011 NHC Tour will be playing for prize money only** since non-members of the 2011 NHC Tour are ineligible to win spots in the NHC Tour finals.
- The weekend contest is limited to 200 paid entries.
- There is a limit of three paid entries per person each weekend contest.
- Each weekend, the **THREE** top finishers will qualify for the DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship (NHC) held in Las Vegas in January, 2012, along with a roundtrip travel voucher to Las Vegas from Ontario, California or elsewhere (with a maximum value of \$250.00) as well as three nights paid hotel accommodations (room and tax only) at the NHC tournament site. If any of the top finishers has already qualified for the 2011 NHC or is otherwise not eligible, then the next highest ranking finisher will qualify in their place.
- Prize money(*) will be paid as follows:

First Place:	\$10,000	Second Place:	\$2,500
Third Place:	\$1,500	Fourth Place:	\$1,000

(**Prize money levels based on 150 paid entrants per contest. Amount will be proportionately reduced or increased with fewer or additional entrants. Prize money for 100 or fewer paid entrants will be 50% of what is shown above.*)
- Each contestant will receive an Official Fairplex-supplied contestant card with \$80 prior to the beginning of the contest. No additional funds may be added or transferred to this card at any time.
- Contestants will make at least one bet in each of the last eight live races at Fairplex Park on each contest day. Each bet will be a single race bet (i.e. Win, Place, Show, Quinella, Exacta or Trifecta) with the exception of Superfecta. No multiple race wagers are permitted for this contest. **Each contestant must bet a minimum of \$4.00 per race (or incur penalties as shown below)** using any, or all, of the available single race bet wagers. The maximum bet would be the amount available on the contest card. The contestant is out of the contest if the amount available on the contest card ever becomes less than \$1.00.
- Wagers can only be made using the Official Fairplex-supplied contest cards.
- **The player is solely responsible for all wagers.** Any player making a wager outside of the contest rules will be disqualified. Official program numbers should always be used when placing all wagers.

- Any funds left on the contestant card at the end of the contest remains the property of the contestant.
- All selections must be made prior to post time of a contest race. Selections must be placed like a wager using self service machines and **CAN NOT** be accepted through pari-mutuel clerks.
- Fairplex Park is not responsible for lost contest cards.
- Rankings in the contest will be determined by the money on each contestant's Fairplex-supplied contest card less any penalties incurred determining the contestant score. In each instance that a contestant bets less than a total of \$4.00 per contest race, their score will be reduced by the amount wagered under \$4.00 which may affect amounts of subsequent contest bets. In unlikely case of ties, the tiebreaker will be the contestant which wagered the most money.
- Liability for any and all federal, state or local taxes is solely the responsibility of the prize winners.
- You must be at least 21 years of age to participate in this tournament.
- Employees of Fairplex Park, Sportech, SCOTWINC or Cornucoppia, or their family members, or their affiliates, are ineligible to compete.
- Liability for any and all federal, state or local taxes is solely the responsibility of the prize winners.
- The management of Fairplex Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions with regard to this event, without claim for damages or recourse in any kind. All questions and definitions not covered explicitly in these rules will be decided by the management of Fairplex Park, with those decisions to be final. Winners will be posted around the track and notified by mail and/or over the phone if prize is not claimed within one week of the contest completion.
- By participating in this contest, the player agrees to be bound by the terms of these rules and agrees to release the use of player's name, photograph, voice and likeness for the purpose of advertising and promotion without compensation.
